Admission of freshmen to the lowa Regent universities is based on the Regent Admission
Index (RAI) formula described below. In addition, applicants must meet the minimum high school course requirements for the university they wish to enter.
$(3 \times$ ACT composite score)
$+(30 \times$ high school GPA)
$+(30 \times$ nigh school GPA)
$+(5 \times$ number of years of high school core courses)
Regent Admission Index Score

Note: For purposes of calculating the RAI, SAT scores will be converted to ACT composite
equivalents, 4.00 is the top value for GPA, and the number of high school core courses completed is expressed in terms of years or fractions of years (e.g., one semester equals 0.5 completed is expressed in terms of years or fractions of years (e.g., one semester equals 0.5
year). Applicants who do not possess all required factors will be evaluated on an individual
basis by the Regent universities to which they apply.

Freshman applicants who achieve at least 245 RAI score and who meet the minimum umber of high school courses required by the Regent universities will qualify for automatic 245 RAl score may also be admitted to a specific Regent university howe hover, each Regent a 24 RAl score may also be admitted to a specitic Regent university; however, each Regent be specific to each institution.
